





Christopher Columbus		Second person ever to sail non-stop around the World. Second in command of the English Navy fighting the Spanish Armada in 1588 for Queen Elizabeth I.
Captain Cook		Led the first successful mission to the South Pole in 1910.
Francis Drake		One of the first explorers to visit China and the first to write about it.

<p>Roald Amundson</p>	 A portrait of Roald Amundson, a Norwegian explorer, wearing a red turban and a heavy, patterned coat.	<p>First European to find Hawaii and Australia. First to sail around New Zealand.</p>
<p>Neil Armstrong</p>	 A portrait of Neil Armstrong, an American astronaut, sitting in a chair and reading a newspaper.	<p>Was the first explorer to reach the top of Mount Everest with Sherpa Tenzing Norgay from Nepal.</p>
<p>Marco Polo</p>	 A black and white portrait of Marco Polo, an Italian explorer, smiling and wearing a suit and tie.	<p>Organised the Spanish expedition to the East Indies. It was the first trip around the Earth.</p>
<p>Sir Edmund Hillary</p>	 A portrait of Sir Edmund Hillary, a New Zealand explorer, wearing a white astronaut suit and holding his helmet, with the Earth in the background.	<p>Discovered North and South America</p>
