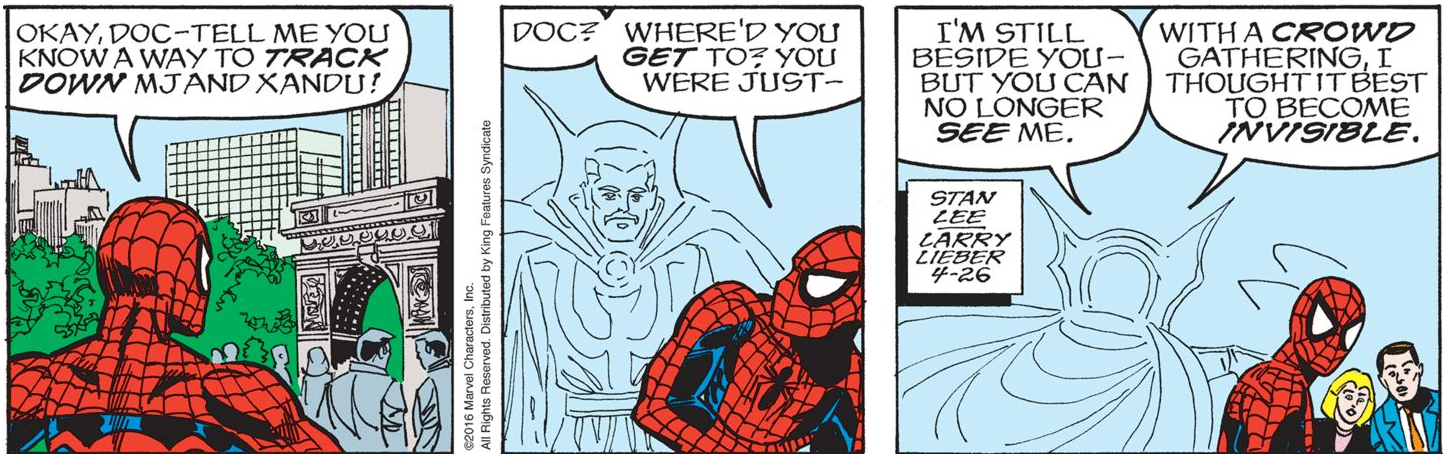


Superheroes

Here is an example of a comic strip.



Notice that the story is told through the pictures and what the characters say.

The character's speech is in speech marks.

You can show a character's thoughts using a thinking bubble.

A box can be used to give narrative information such as: Later..., At the park..., When he got home...

Today you will create your own comic strip.

First you will need to create your superhero character.

Your comic strip today will explain how your superhero got (or found out about) their superhero powers.

You are going to need at least 6 boxes. You could draw these yourself or I have included one on the next page.

Remember your story should have a beginning, a middle and an end. Use the first two boxes to illustrate what happened before. The 3rd and 4th box should show what happened to give them their power. The 5th box should show what they did after. The last box can show what they do with their power now.
